*The number of community members accessing our food bank has definitely increased but with ongoing support like yours, we are able to continue to provide food supplies to those in need.*

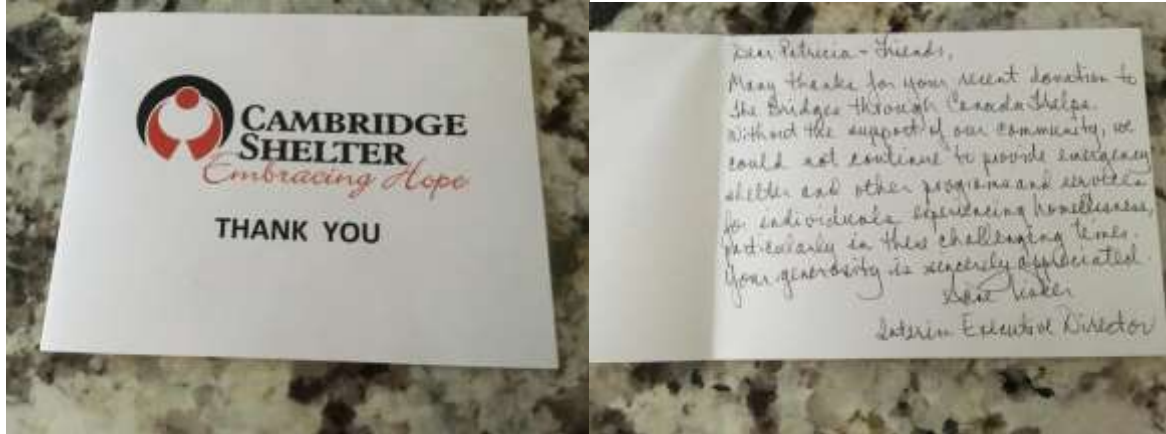

Oh so easy...'**Strawberry Puff Surprise**' submitted by Lynne Goulet-Smith.

Preheat oven to 400°F.

1 c flour  
Pinch salt  
2 tsp baking powder  
½ c milk  
¼ tsp vanilla  
¾ c sugar  
2 tbsp softened butter  
1 egg  
2 ½ - 3 c fresh/frozen strawberries

Place washed and cut up fruit in bottom of baking dish. Sprinkle with ¼ c sugar. Mix all dry ingredients. Add milk, vanilla, butter and egg. Mix well. Spread dough over top of fruit. Bake for 30-40 mins till golden brown. Serve with fresh, slightly sweetened whipped cream.
